The courses offer a discussion and evaluation of the ongoing process of transition and transformation of the Arab countries of the region, under the light of this year's events.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

There will be some scholarships sponsored by IBEI. The selection of candidates will be based on a number of criteria: young faculty or PhD students citizens from the Mediterranean area (non-EU countries). Interested persons must send to IBEI (by post or email summer@ibei.org), until 10th June 2011, a letter of interest, a curriculum vitae; a recommendation letter; and a document from his/her university that credits his/her position.

The scholarships will cover accommodation in Barcelona for a week and two courses fees.

#### **CERTIFICATION**

At the end of each course you will get an IBEI's certificate of attendance, if you attend more than 80 % of the sessions.
